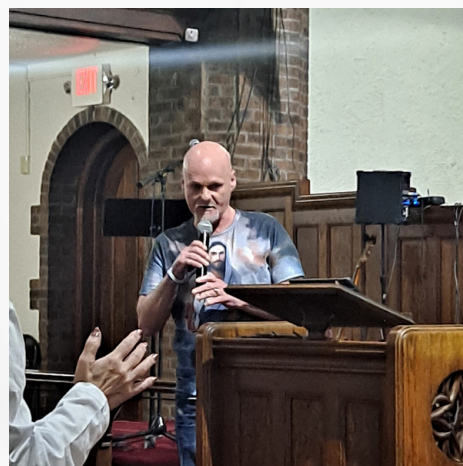

ENABLING

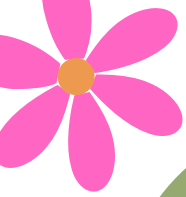

Legislators are reintroducing a bipartisan bill to restore a charitable deduction for non-itemizing taxpayers. The Charitable Act would allow these donors to claim a deduction worth up to one-third of the standard deduction - \$5,000 for individuals or \$10,000 for joint filers in 2025.

Churches and ministries know the value of individuals who selflessly give time and treasure to advance their Christ-honoring mission.

Please call your local legislator and tell them you support the Charitable Act.

And give local to keep the best eye on how your dollars are used.
